What is the Meplato Store API?

The Store API is a REST based service request.

Which conditions do we need to create?

For identification purposes only your Meplato ID, which you can find in your Meplato account is required. In this account you will find an example request of the Store API via the command line to check whether all requirements for the request are given.

You need an account at Meplato!

Do we receive source examples?

We provide supporting source codes (client libraries) for the most common programming languages (Java, .Net, PHP, Go). These clarify the handling of the requests. Only 4 required fields are necessary for the initial creation of a product.

The „client libraries“ are available within your Meplato account!

How does the process of a product creation work?

The 3 steps:

1

Base API:
To check your catalog

2

Catalog creation:
Manually meet the requirements for creating a catalog

3

Product API:
To create, delete and update a product in a catalog

How can I identify errors in my request?

For error handling and interception of error codes, you can find a list of possible error notifications in the related descriptions. After meeting all necessary requirements the entire automation of updating your existing catalogs can be ensured.
